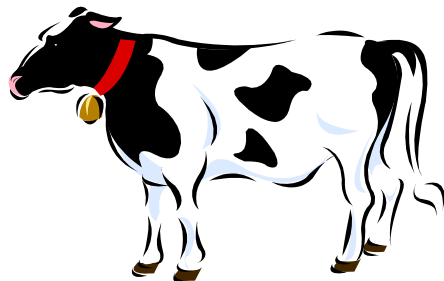

The pre judging dates are July 12 and 13th, with all items to be dropped off at the 4-H Office on July 12 by 4:30 p.m. The items can be picked up on July 13 (time to be announced).

You will be expected to bring your judged items the Saturday before the fair opens so we can place in the 4-H building for the week of fair. It is there that the ribbons will be placed on the items based on the earlier judging.
